Dressage is a step by step training progression for any horse of any breed. It is an excellent foundation for riders of any discipline. Each horse/rider combination rides a Dressage Tests of their choice (a set pattern). Each movement on the tests is given a separate score from 0 to 10 with a 5 being sufficient (the movement was complete). The highest percent total score is named the winner.

Arenas: Be prepared to ride in either size arena.

20x60 or 20x40 meter arenas used. Footing is a sandy loam mix.

For those of you riding tests that don't fit in the small arena the following tests may be used: *Second Level Test S (20x40m arena only), *Third Level Test S (20x40m arena only), remember you can ride each test twice. This will make it possible for riders to continue to ride at their current level when circumstances force us into the small arena. Contact Tammy for more info.

Show Awards:

JR/YR & SR - Rosettes 1st - 6th place (see rule #7).

Rules and Info:

1. **USEF and 4-H / FFA** Rules apply. Informal dress is acceptable. English tack and attire is normally used at Dressage Shows. We will allow the JR/YR division to use the 4-H / FFA rules for Programmed Ride Test 1 & 2, Intro Level Test A & B and Training Level Test 1 & 2. Refer to the Wyoming State 4-H / FFA Rule book, under Programmed Ride. English riders ASTM / SEI certified helmets and heeled boots are required. Western riders ASTM / SEI certified helmets are strongly recommended and heeled boots required.
2. Tests may be called.
3. Show management may cancel, change, combine or split classes, change jump heights or change arena size if circumstances require it.
4. **Entries Closing Date:** Post marked (2) two weeks before show. No entries will be accepted over the phone. Post entries will only be accepted if space and time permits. Post entry fee is an additional \$5.00 per test.
5. Entry form must be completed entirely and full payment of fees must accompany the entry form. All signatures are required.
6. **Substitution** of rider, horse, ride time or class will be made only at the discretion of show management and will require a fee of \$10.00 per test.
7. You can ride the same test twice per horse/rider combination. No more than 4 tests may be ridden per horse per day. When entering a Ribbon class same test twice, the highest scoring test of the 2 will be used for placing. When entering a Jackpot class same test twice, both scores will count for

8. **Ride Times** will be assigned and posted at the show office or dressage arena. **To receive your personal list of tentative ride times before the show**, include your e-mail address on your entry form. Please check the **Official Ride Time Schedule** posted at the show office or dressage arena on show day for possible changes. Please be at the dressage arena at least 10 minutes prior to your scheduled ride time. Failure to enter the arena within 90 seconds after the judge rings the bell signaling the rider to enter the arena results in disqualification. No exhibitor can be required to ride before his or her scheduled time. If circumstances permit, it is a courtesy to the show and judge to accede to a request to ride earlier than their scheduled time.
 9. Tack may be checked before or after entering the arena at the discretion of the show management.
 10. Exhibitor may never warmup nor ride in the official dressage arena, except when called by the judge to ride his or her test.
 11. Exhibitor may warm up around the outside of the official dressage arena while the judge is scoring the previous test ridden.
 12. *In the case of inclement weather, show management may set up time blocks for warm-up inside the official dressage arena when the show is held at the CWC indoor arena.
 13. Class results will be posted when class is completely scored and placed. Tests will not be released nor shown until a class is posted. No test will be released to anyone but the rider or rider's representative. Riders are encouraged to check their test for errors.
 14. Show management reserves the right to refuse the entry of any exhibitor for cause; to have any horse removed from the grounds for cause; to return any entry fee and eliminate the exhibitor for cause; all being without any liability for damage or compensation.
 15. **Scratches:** Refunds will be made only upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian or medical doctor attesting to illness or injury. Statement must be received prior to the day of the show. NO EXCEPTIONS.
 16. **Fair Grounds Stabling:** On grounds, 8x8 covered box stalls \$10.00 per night, bring your own shavings. You must strip the stall clean after use. **Out of County horses stabled on grounds must provide a copy of Neg. Coggins Test taken within 12 months.** Stallions and unruly horses may have to be stabled off grounds. Exhibitors who must travel a long distance will be given first priority to stall horses on grounds during the show. Please complete the stabling form on the reverse side of the entry form. Stall assignments will be made.
 17. **Lameness:** In the case of marked lameness the judge informs the exhibitor that he or she is eliminated. There is no appeal against the judge's decision.
 18. **Veterinarian and Farrier List:** Posted at the Show office.
 19. **Concessions:** On grounds during the Fair Show.
 20. **Accommodations and Directions:** Available at the Fremont County Fair web sit, www.fremontcountyfair.org
 21. **Jackpot pay off chart:** 2 monies 60, 40. 3 monies 50, 30, 20. 4 monies 40, 30, 20, 10. 5 monies 37, 27, 19, 10, 7. 6 monies 34, 26, 18, 10, 7, 5. 8 monies 30, 24, 17, 10, 7, 5, 4, 3. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the chart at their discretion. JR/YR - \$5.00, SR - \$10.00 of the entry fee goes in for the jackpot.
 22. Exhibition Class - Exhibition only, may be done during lunch bread, not judged.
 23. Follow Along Test: Is a test ridden with a more experienced lead horse/rider combination, riding the test ahead of a new to dressage horse/rider combination. The lead horse will not be judged. This is a great way to help individuals learn the tests and build confidence.
