5. Age classification: Base date of August 1, 2010.
6. Exhibitors may exhibit one goat per class. If you would like to enter more goats, please notify the superintendent.
7. All does in the show must be dehorned naturally or naturally polled.
8. **ENTRY INFORMATION:** The Class Code must include the Department letter, the Division number and Class number. The ages listed are based on the show date being August 3, 2010.
- EXAMPLE:** If you are entering Alpine in Junior Kids-born after April 1; your entry would be C-4-1(C for Open Department; 4 for Dairy Goat Division; and 1 for Junior Kids under Alpine).

Rules

1. Animals registered as a 4-H of FFA project may be exhibited in the open show.
2. Goats must be owned by the individual exhibiting the animal. Animals must have a legible Tattoo or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified. If the animal is registered with a microchip, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.
3. Exhibitor may show no more than two animals in each class.
4. Classes may be combined at the discretion of the superintendent.

7. Ages shall be determined as of August 1 of the current year.
8. Minimum weight 70 lbs.

Rules

1. Exhibitor may have two entries in a class, providing entries are different breeds. In classes where there is no competition, prizes will be awarded at the judge's discretion. A bird entered as a single cannot compete in a trio or pen of three.
2. Cockerels and Pullets must have been hatched during the current year. A trio shall consist of one male and two females.
3. Exhibitors must be present to assist in judging their exhibits.
4. Classes will be divided as necessary by age.
5. For "Trio or Laying Flock", birds may be purebred or crossbred, but all three birds must be of the same variety or breeding.
6. All birds will be aged prior to the show. **No birds over 2 years old.**
7. No cages available for open class birds.
