- E. For Levels 1 and 2, leashes can be up to 6 ft in length, may be as short as 6 inch pull tab, or of key fob varieties. Collars must be of a flat, buckle variety with nothing hanging from it such as tags.
- F. Bait is not allowed in agility competition.
- G. Dogs in season will run at the end of each class.
- H. A time for all handlers (only) to familiarize themselves with the course they are competing in will be established and announced.
- I. Fastest times will be used to break ties on scores at all levels.
