Rules

- 4-H and FFA exhibitors may not enter animals which have been designated as 4-H and FFA exhibits; except in the Breeders Pen of 3 Market Animals Contest.
- The placing of animal exhibited is left to the discretion of the judge. A champion animal in each breed, regardless of the number exhibited, may be designated at the judge's discretion.

BREEDER PEN OF 3 MARKET ANIMALS: C-1-*

Rules

- Breeders are requested to enter in advance.
- Gate entries at time of show will be accepted in this division only, for a fee.
- Three market animals in each class—must have been bred by one breeder and shown in the 4-H/FFA Junior Livestock Show. Breeder must reside in Fremont County; all animals must have been born in Fremont County to a Fremont County breeder.
- Awards for Market Hogs, Market Goats, Market Lambs, and Market Beef.

Rules

- All entries in breed classes must be purebred.
- Classes may be divided as necessary.
- Exhibitor may enter one animal per class. (If you would like to exhibit more hogs please notify the superintendent prior to the show).
- No gilts or boars farrowed prior to 2010 will be allowed to show.
- Date for determining boar and gilt ages:
 - Jr. boar or gilt-farrowed after March 1, 2010.
 - Sr. boar or gilt-farrowed between January 1 and February 28, 2010.
- Boar exhibits must be of high quality. Purebred or Crossbred boars may be shown. Purebred boars must meet breed registration requirements. No boars allowed in Market Classes.
- ENTRY INFORMATION:** The Class code must include the Department letter, the Division number and Class number.
EXAMPLE: If you are entering a Duroc in Class No. 1; your class entry would be: C-2-1. (C for Open Show; 2 for Breeding Swine Division; and 1 for Duroc Jr. Gilt class.)
