

FREMONT COUNTY FAIR DEMOLITION DERBY

SPONSERD BY: RIVERTON ELKS & FREMONT COUNTY FAIR BOARD

RULES

1. No reinforcing cars except driver's door with grater blade or pipe that extends no more that 8 inches past the seams on both sides of the driver's door. 1/8" of an inch by 1" strap metal may be used to weld the seams of your car.
2. Hood may be bolted if angle iron is used no more than a TOTAL of 8 inches can be used. Hood bolts may be attached to frame or chained.
3. Hood & deck lid can be welded to bumper **but cannot add extra iron (No Exceptions).**
4. Hardtop cars may add a center post on right side to protect the driver.
5. Driver's seat may be reinforced in back.
6. Station wagon rear seats may be left in & may be BOLTED OR WELDED with 8 inch strap 10 inches apart to keep them from flopping.
7. **Cars only!!!!** NO Jeeps, Trucks, Suburbans or Convertibles.
8. All chrome trim and glass **MUST BE REMOVED** including license plate light. No glass left in bottom of doors.
9. Transmission coolers will be allowed inside of car all lines must be covered. (Ducked Tape or Tin)
10. No spare water tanks.
11. Fuel tank must be removed. A small tank (boat tank) must be placed inside car in the rear middle or rear driver's side no more than a 5 gallon tank. **The tank must be securely tied down, no bungee straps!!**
12. Hood must have an access to motor.
13. Deck Lid must have access to look in.
14. Batteries must be securely mounted to the floor. Rubber hood to cover the top for protection against acid splashes etc. **No bungee straps No pump straps & No coolers.**
15. Electric fuel pumps may be used with a shut off switch. **Switch must have a 1" x 1" red square to indicate fuel.**
16. No bumper hitches, tire chains, trailer hitches or bumper guards are allowed.
17. Reinforced fire wall or dash is legal.
18. Bumpers may be welded to frame.
19. **NO ALCOHOL allowed in pits during race, coolers will be checked!!**

20. **NO** double skinning.
21. Wheel wells may be cut.
22. The driver's door must be a contrasting color to the rest of the car. The number of the car must be on both sides and on the top of the car and measure no less than two feet in height so the judges and timers can see them.
23. Full Roll Bar is legal.
24. Inspections will begin at 2:00 p.m. All cars must be ready for inspection for 5:30 p.m.

Heat Rules

- Seatbelts and helmets are required, eye protection are required.
- **NO DELIBERATE HITTING OF THE DRIVERS DOOR**, you will be DQ'ed.
- Drivers must not leave their car, remove their helmets or seat belts during the race or the driver is disqualified.
- If a car passes 3 tires over the arena boundary line, (center of the logs) you are disqualified.
- Drivers must hit another car every three minutes or they will be disqualified or considered stalled and out of the race. A 30 second warning will be announced. No exceptions, **NO LOVE TAPS!**
- A fire will halt the race. If your car starts on fire you are automatically disqualified from the heat of the race, but you are qualified to participate in the consolation heat.
- All heat winners must leave their cars in the holding area until after the consolation heat. At this time the drivers and crew will be allowed to release their cars. Any attempt before this will result in the disqualification of car, crew, and driver.
- Any protests from the drivers must be received in writing no later than 30 minutes after the final heat. **Decisions will be made by the judges and they are FINAL!**
- Drivers must remove their cars no later than one day after the race or they will be considered a donation to the Elks. Also a \$20.00 towing fee will be enforced and a suspension for one year from our race.
- Rules may be added by the Demolition Derby Committee should there be an issue not previously mentioned above.
- **CARS MUST BE READY TO RACE NO LATER THAN 6 P.M. ALL DRIVERS MUST ATTEND THE DRIVERS MEETING AT 6:30 P.M. OR THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE. RACE WILL START PROMPTLY AT 7:00 P.M.**

DEMOLITION DERBY
Release, Assumption or Risk and Indemnity Agreement**

1. The undersigned, hereby requests to be granted permission (1) to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in an event held at the Fremont County Fairgrounds, or any other sanctioned activity of the Fremont County Fair Board. (2) to enter the restricted area (3) to compete for money, prizes, recognition or awards.
2. I understand that entry into the restricted area and/or participation contains **DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH**, that animals and ATVs are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is **INHERENT DANGER** which I appreciate and voluntarily assume because I choose to do so. I have observed events of this type and I seek to participate. I further understand that the arena's surface, access ways or lack thereof, light or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to me. I further understand that the contestants and participants pose a danger, but nevertheless, **I VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISK** connected with entry into the restricted area and/or participation in any events.
3. **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** and release the Fremont County Fair Board and its officers, agents and employees from any and all loss, liability, damage, or cost that may occur due to the presence of participants to the described activities where caused by negligence or release or otherwise.
4. **I AGREE** that this agreement shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and manifesting itself thereafter. All subsequent agreements and release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall amplify, but shall in no way limit the provisions of this document.
5. I further understand that I will be responsible for any damage done by my livestock and/or ATVs.

WE HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, WE UNDERSTAND IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS, WE APPRECIATE AND ASSUME ALL RISKS INHERENT IN ALL EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES.
